



Grades of AC Sprain



Discussion

Presentation neck/shoulder pain

History impact, fall, exertion, RSI

Tender points trapezius, deltoid insertion, serratus, pectorals

Muscle testing medial deltoid: beware patient recruitment of other groups

OMM articulatory, HVLA, BLT

Exercises fwd, side, back, for 2-3 weeks +/-weight, PALM FACING

Taping from point of scapula, lift skin over pecs, apply (support AC)
